- Dr. Nitin Joshi appreciated the IQAC team for successful submission of SSR and subsequent DVV clarifications. IQAC team informed that the dates of site visit were announced viz. 8th and 9th August 2019.
- 2. Dr. Smita Jape updated everyone about the initiative of 'Focused Group' for research. Dr. Pallavi Chandwaskar discussed the milestones to ensure the research papers of all faculties are published in reputed journals preferably UGC approved, Scopus indexed.
- 3. Inorder to facilitate knowledge exchange and exchange of ideas within specialization groups, there should be a specialization head. Accordingly, the following specialization heads were decided : Finance Specialization Dr.Smita Jape, Marketing Specialization Dr. Pallavi Chandwaskar, HR Specialization Dr. Sukhada Tambe, Operations Specialization Shekhar Velagaleti
- 4. The need for revamp in ADC was discussed.
- 5. Prof. Mahesh Bhanushali suggested that there is a need to revisit the teaching-learning plan (TLP). IQAC decided that a separate meeting to held to take this suggestion forward and restructure and redesign the TLP.
- 6. Dr. Nitin Joshi appreciated the efforts of the placement team for the final placements and summer internships. Prof. Mahesh Bhanushali expressed his desire of increasing the average package of students. It was decided that inorder to enhance the employability of the students, certain value builders e.g. communication skills, business research, current affairs, personality development to be given to the students.
- 7. Dr. Sukhada Tambe suggested that the institute should conduct Academic and Administrative Audit for enhancing the quality of academics. IQAC unanimously decided that in next two years the institute will go for Academic Administrative Audit in order to further improve the quality of academics at our institute.

- 8. Dr. Smita Jape shared that she has already submitted a proposal for establishing 'Financial Lab' at our institute and was very keen on having it at our institute.
- 9. Dr. Sukhada Tambe thanked the teachers and students for successfully conducting and participating in the Learnbiz Simulation for MMS and PGDM students. She suggested that next year we should also purchase the HR module.
