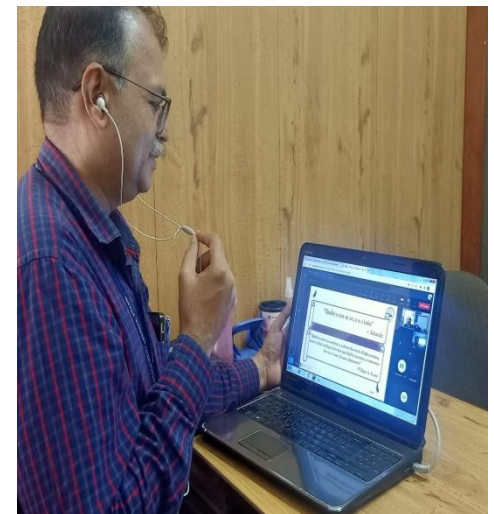

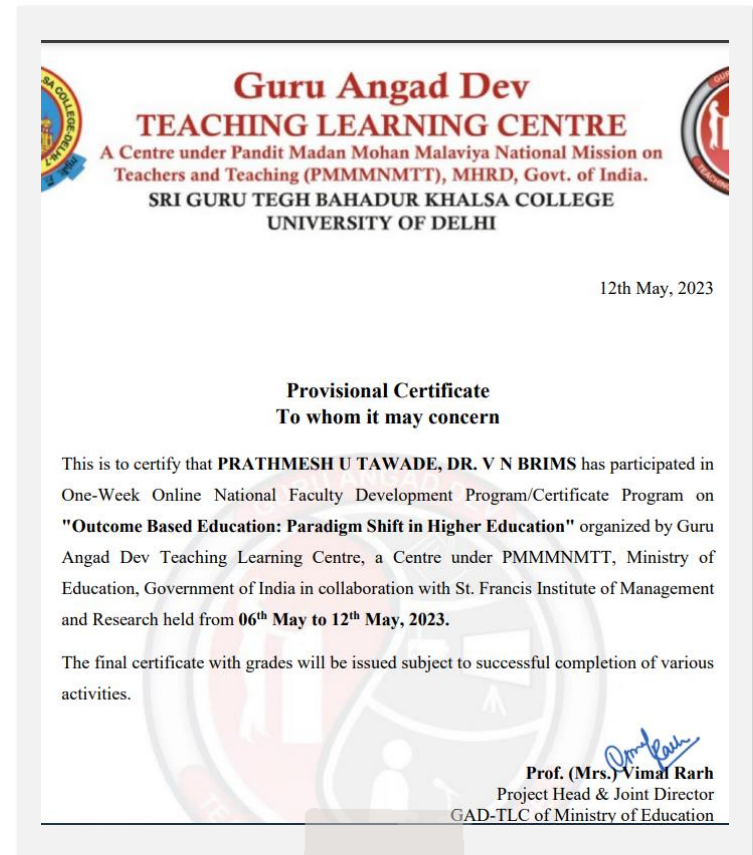


Abstract

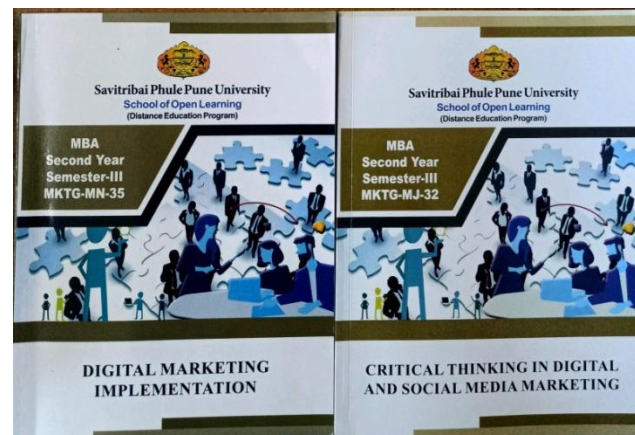

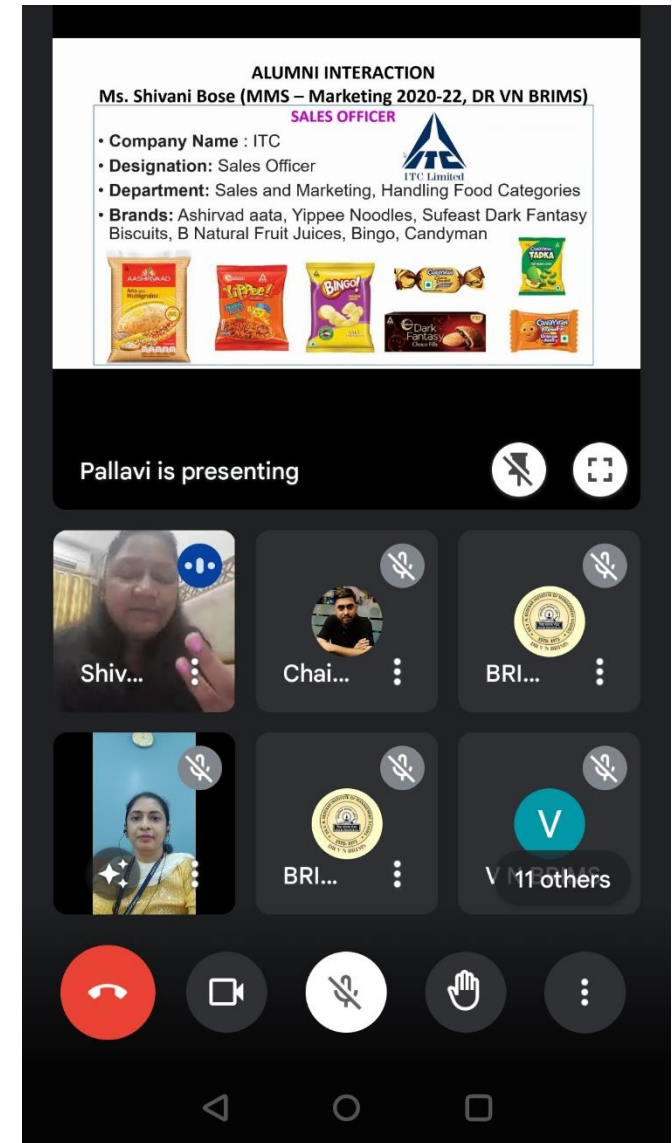
